SPB-1927 Draft Filters and Rules

The following draft filters for the upcoming SPB-1927 Draft:

The SPB-1927 Filler Draft will consist of (3) Phases. Two (10) Round Drafts, and one (10.6 Round Draft)

Draft orders for this draft have been set up using a weighted system, with each pick in each round getting a value, and those values would be added together across all rounds to insure that there is a level playing field and the picks are distributed evenly. The order will be determined using the State Lottery system, which has been previously outlined.

PHASE 1

During the 1st 10 rounds of the Inaugural Draft, each team will select no more than the following:

- 1 catcher
- 1 First Baseman
- 1 Second Baseman
- 1 Shortstop
- 1 Third Baseman
- 1 Centerfielder
- 2 Corner Outfielders (Left or Right Fielders)
- 2 Pitchers (Starter or Reliever)

*Note, these positions will be based on the players Primary Position as listed on the 1927 Database. Even if a player plays multi positions, you may only draft them at their primary position. Once you have selected or filled your slots at these positions, you will not be able to draft another player at that position until the next phase begins.

PHASE 2

During the next 10 rounds, each team will select the following:

- 1 backup catcher
- 2 infielders (1B, 2B, 3B or SS)
- 2 outfielders (LF, CF or RF)
- 3 Starting Pitchers
- 2 Relief Pitchers

*Again, these positions will be based on the players Primary Position as listed on the 1927 Database. Phase 2 is a little more flexible with IF's and OF's, however if you are drafting an IF, their primary position must be in the infield. For outfielder in Phase 2, they can play any three of the outfield spots (LF/CF/RF). Once you have selected or filled your slots at these positions, you will not be able to draft another player at that position until the next phase begins.

PHASE 3

In the remaining rounds (21-30), teams may choose from any of the remaining available players with no filters or limitations.

This will be an email draft and each team will have assigned times to pick each day.

Draft Rules

During the first 2 Phases, each team will be given a 1 hour allotment in which to make their pick and we will only go 1 round per day. In Phase 3, each team will be given a 30 minute allotment, and we will go 2 rounds per day.

For example, if the Frankfort Frogs draft time is at 9am EST on 8/29, then Gary would have until 10:00am to make his choice. If Gary does not pick within his time block, his pick is passed and the team at 10:00am may choose. Gary may still chime in at anytime to make his pick, but the team that is on the clock has first dibs on the player if there is a conflict.

If your pick is passed, the draft will proceed as if you had picked, so if the team after Gary picks at 9:00am, the next team at 10am may pick also, and so-on, and so-on, and so-on.....

If the team prior to yours has picked, you may make your pick at anytime, so by using the example above, if Gary picks at 9:00am, then the next team can pick immediately.

You may not make a pick until the team prior to yours has picked OR their time block has passed and yours has begun.

Note: If your team has not picked at the end of the following days picks at 10pm EST, your team WILL be assigned a player by league officers, so make sure you get those picks in...Failure to select players twice during the draft may result in the loss of your franchise:)

The bottom line here is to keep things moving. Since you will know your scheduled time to pick, if you know you can't be available, just send your list to me and I will make sure that your pick gets made.
